TRAINING OF TRAINERS COURSE

Perugia, February 2026 and Petra, April 2026

CESF Perugia, as the implementing body of the project *“High-Quality Architectural Restoration as a Driver for Economic Development in the Construction and Tourism Sectors in Jordan / Rebuild”* (AID 013244/12/7), co-financed by AICS – the Italian Agency for Development Cooperation – under the *2023 Call for Proposals for the Awarding of Grants to Initiatives Promoted by Local Authorities and Civil Society Organizations (and other non-profit entities registered in the list referred to in paragraph 3, article 26 of Law no. 125/2014)*,

invites applications from Jordanian professionals for the selection of 10 trainers (men and women) who will serve as instructors in restoration technician courses within the framework of the Re-Build Project

Course Objective

To prepare conservation professionals to design and deliver capacity-building programs for unemployed individuals interested in working in the restoration and conservation of cultural and architectural heritage, with a focus on innovative materials and techniques.

Target Group

Professionals seeking to become trainers in architectural conservation.

Eligibility Requirements

Education

- Bachelor's or Master's degree in Architecture, Building Engineering, Conservation of Cultural Heritage, or related fields

- Vocational Training in restoration/conservation of architectural heritage

Professional Experience

- Minimum 1 year of documented practical experience in architectural or archaeological conservation (construction sites, design, project management, technical consulting, teaching, or conservation workshops)

Teaching Skills

- Previous experience in training, technical tutoring, or dissemination in the field

Knowledge

- Familiarity with current Jordanian regulations and technical standards on restoration and conservation

Motivation

- Strong commitment to pursuing or advancing a career in adult education

Availability

- Willingness to work as a trainer in conservation vocational programs, particularly those focused on innovative materials and techniques for young unemployed Jordanians

Selection Process

Candidates will be evaluated on the basis of submitted documentation and a motivational interview. Criteria include:

- Relevance of profile to the course objectives
- Professional and teaching experience
- Motivation to participate

Application Procedure

Applications must be submitted no later than November 15, 2025 and include:

 - Technical/specialist training
 - Training in adult learning methodologies (andragogy)
